## INTERDISCIPLINARY TRAINING FOR EARLY INTERVENTION PROFESSIONALS

The goal of these Master's level courses is to enhance the knowledge and skills of professionals currently working in the field of early intervention.

### Training Model:

- Three web-based interactive Courses
- Monthly Community of Practice Meetings
- Applied training competencies and consultation

### Training Format:

- Twelve month long program
- Three courses 15 sessions each
  - Family-centered Practices
  - Evaluation and Assessment
  - Intervention Strategies

#### To enroll in the program you must:

- Have a Bachelor's degree or higher
- Currently be employed as an early intervention provider in Connecticut
- Be providing services in high-need communities
- Have access to a computer
